Site:	Betsey Anna
Max depth:	25m
GPS Marks:	50 36.974N 01 48.945W (not so good but possible to find it) Better marks in the large GPS under either 220 and 221 or 221 and 222. The wreck is lying along the line between those marks.
Brief description:	Very nice wreck and right depth for inexperienced divers or a second dive. Feels like diving in an aquarium. Tons of fish, including enormous congers and John Dorys.

Dive 2	
Site:	Fleur de Lys (Fishing boat in the Swanage Bay)
Max depth:	13m
GPS Marks:	In the large GPS under FISHBOAT.
Brief description:	Little fishing boat. Buoyed with a 20lt white can. It is located on a line between the point opposite the pier (end of the cliffs) and the pier, 300m from the cliffs. Very small wreck with lots of fish (and a resident lobster). Can do a drift in the area afterwards but bottom doesn't have much to offer.

GPS Marks:	50 34.908N 01 56.630W (bow) 50 34.943N 01 56.560W (stern)
Brief description:	Very good wreck and very short distance from Swanage (~1.8nm). In rough waters, though, and needs to be dived right on slack.
